



Transfer Program to Avila University
Education (Elementary and Middle School with Special Ed. minor)
 2018-2019 Catalog (Secondary Ed. minors may also follow this guide)

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Approval as an education major requires:

- SAT or ACT scores
- *a minimum 2.75 GPA with minimum "C" grades in English I, II, Speech and Math.
- a passing score on the MoGEA for Missouri Certification (ask about Kansas Certification requirements)

A minimum of 120 hours is required for the degree; at least 64 semester hours must be completed at four-year institutions. The final thirty (30) hours must be completed at Avila University. A minimum GPA of 2.0 (C) is required for graduation in all work attempted, including transfer credits. At least 12 upper-division hours in the major must be completed at Avila. All upper-division courses in the major must have a minimum grade of C.
