1. Must be a Johnson County resident.
2. Must have completed one semester of full-time or two semesters of part time study in one of the Horticulture Certification programs with at least 6 credits of horticulture courses from the required class list in the JCCC horticulture curriculum.
3. Letters of recommendation from:
 - A. One JCCC faculty member
 - B. One professional or personal reference from a non-family member
4. A copy of transcripts showing all completed coursework
5. Proof of full or part time enrollment in the following spring semester
6. Submission of completed application, questionnaire and recommendation letters by application deadline.

A check for \$500 will be awarded to apply toward tuition, fees and books for the spring semester. A second check for \$500 will be awarded upon proof of completion of the Certification program. Recipient may be required to meet with Extension Master Gardener Advisory Board.
