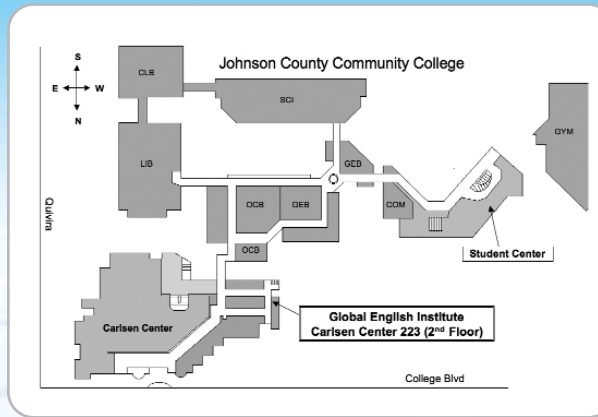




About Johnson County Community College

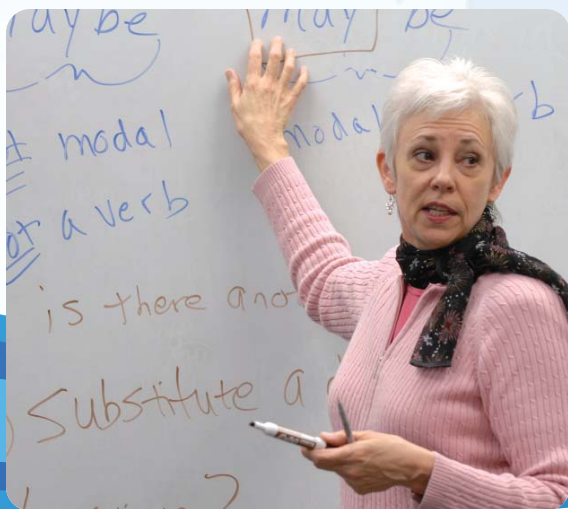

- Payment plans are available for all students.
