- The systemwide transfer degree provides a pathway from any Kansas public community college
  offering the degree to any Kansas public university for individuals desiring to become licensed as a PK6 elementary teacher. The pathway identifies courses/credit hours to be taken at the community
  college level and reflect the Kansas Board of Regents (KBOR) General Education framework "buckets"
  (<a href="https://www.kansasregents.org/academic affairs/general-education/seven-bucket-framework">https://www.kansasregents.org/academic affairs/general-education/seven-bucket-framework</a>) and
  recommended education coursework.
