The AAS in Marketing Management at JCCC transfers to Park University with the opportunity to take additional credit hours that transfer in to meet degree requirements. A maximum of 75 hours from all two-year schools can be applied toward a Park undergraduate degree with residency requirement of 30 hours at Park with 15 hours in the major core.

TRANSFER STUDENT ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- You must have a cumulative 2.0 GPA in all previous college study.
- You must submit all transcripts from prior college work completed.
- If you've earned less than 60 hours of college credit, must also submit an official high school transcript or GED.
