### Transfer Admission Procedures/Qualifications

- Application can be completed on-line with the assistance of a Rasmussen College program manager. Application deadlines are rolling based on the start date prospective students are interested in, with start dates available at multiple times a year. An attestation of high school graduation or equivalency must be provided.
- ACT and SAT scores are not required for transfer students.
- Official evaluation of transcripts is not made until all transcripts are received and enrollment agreement is completed. However, unofficial and “estimate” reviews can be done before this stage.

### Estimated Tuition/Fees/Expenses for the 2015-16 Academic Year

- There is a required course materials fee of \$150 per course. Course numbers ending with “L” or “LL” will not be charged a course materials fee.

### Transfer Credit/Grading Policies

- Grade points from other institutions will not be computed into the Rasmussen College GPA, but will be counted as credits attempted and earned for determining Satisfactory Academic Progress.
