Items for Consideration:

- By-Laws review and update
 - College Council does not have a mechanism for asking questions of administration around policy changes or to ask for recommendations to be considered
 - ABC has the ability for faculty to consider a recommendation
 - A possible mechanism for College Council to adopt would be a "Council Inquiry" that would be moved froward from governing bodies, up to College Council, and to the key decision-makers
 - The "inquiry" is to ask for consideration around a topic and a timeframe for a response
 - \circ $\;$ Built-in issue tracking and a way for folks to view progress and keep tabs on an issue
 - Need buy-in from Cabinet for this to be effective
- Communication subcommittee update

- Employing analytics software and transcripts to look for themes
- Working with IR to find themes from which broad recommendations can be brought forward
