<u>ALICE – Enhanced Armed Intruder Response</u>

The enhanced course has been designed with trauma informed training in mind.

- Statistics show that more people have experienced some sort of trauma in their lives
- Separated into 2 training categories or "buckets"
 - Awareness and Communication
 - Response Options
- There is no "one size fits all" when it comes to Response.
- Target rollout April 1, 2023, for in person revised training.
- Reduced presentation time; 30-40 minutes
- Work group training upon request
- New employees are already receiving the new enhanced curriculum in their 40-minute online module from Navigate360.
- Staff & Development and EM are working on a new ALICE video module for various uses.
- We have 2 new ALICE instructors that have been trained on the revised in-person curriculum
 - These 2 trainers are sharing the training the other ALICE instructors.
- ALICE is still a training tool that we must rely on and refresh.
