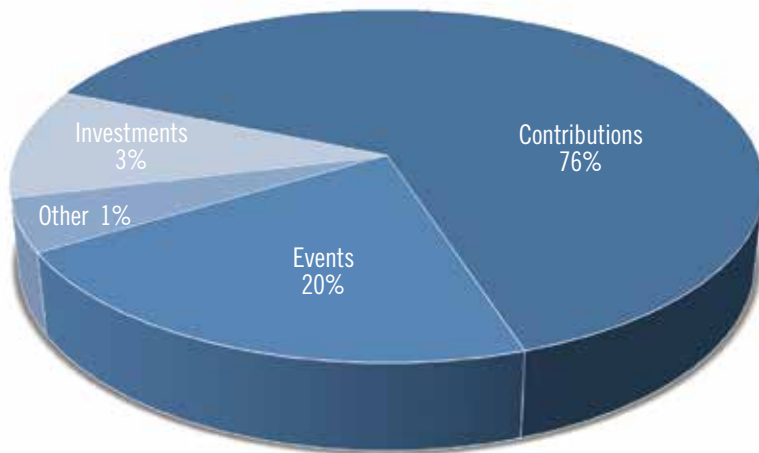

scholarship created by a donor.

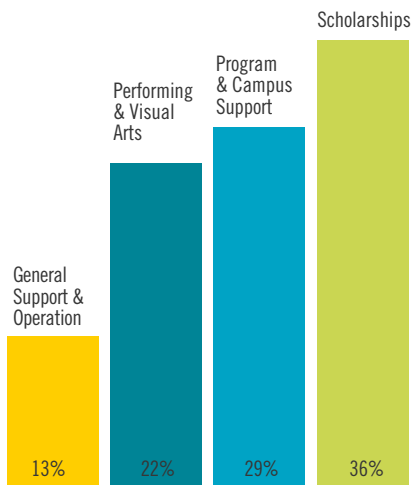
IBT, Industrial Solutions created the

JCCC Foundation Giving



The JCCC Foundation allocates the vast majority of its annual budget to scholarships, academic program support and visual/performing arts programming.

Notable Contributions

The Wylie Hospitality and Culinary Academy was named after a

\$1 million pledge from the **Jack and Glenna Wylie Foundation**

to support hospitality and culinary programming.

\$75,000 from the **Educate, Enrich and Enable Fund**

for international service-learning projects, healthcare simulation education and scholarships

The Adams Family Arts Education Endowment

was established with

\$30,000 to create the first endowment benefitting performing arts education.

Money Matters

\$1.1 million to JCCC students for books, tuition and programming

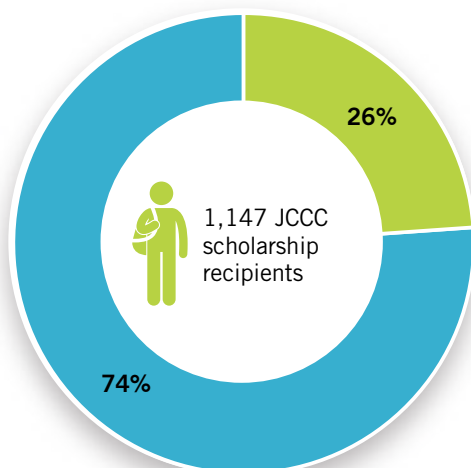
1,147 students received Foundation scholarships
