


# JCCC FOUNDATION 2017-2018 IN REVIEW

## Total Income: \$14,715,227



Through expansive fundraising efforts, the JCCC Foundation supports student scholarships, programs and cultural arts at the College. Here are some of this year's highlights:

### **New Scholarships**

\$125,000 from the M.R. and Evelyn Hudson Foundation towards a scholarship for single parents.

The Janet Alholm Interior

Design Endowment became the first endowed Interior Design scholarship and raised nearly

\$40.000.

\$26,000 from the McCown Family Foundation for scholarships to first generation college students and single parents.

The Carol H. Logan and Fred R. Logan, Jr. Endowment pledged \$25,000 to first generation students, students who are children of undocumented persons and beleaguered students.

Annual black-tie gala **Some Enchanted Evening**generated more than

**\$630,000** for scholarships.

**\$100,000** from the **Jedel Family Trust** for Nerman Museum of Contemporary Art acquisitions and programming.


More than \$187,000 from the Friends of the Carlsen Center, in gifts, grants and sponsorships to support Carlsen Center programming.

### **JCCC Foundation Giving**



The JCCC Foundation allocates the vast majority of its annual budget to scholarships, academic program support and visual/ performing arts programming.

### **Notable Contributions**

A \$10 million lead gift from the Sunderland Foundation as the college embarks on the largest campus transformation project in its history.

Drs. David and Mary Zamierowski pledged **\$2 million** for construction renovations to our Nursing Department and Simulation Center.

The **Sharon Tiley Estate** contributed nearly **\$300,000** for the silversmithing program in our new Fine Arts & Design Studios.

### **Money Matters**

More than **\$1.2** million awarded to JCCC students for books, tuition and programming.

**1,120 students** received Foundation scholarships.
