The sharp decline at census for this population had an impact on a variety of metrics. Additionally, COVID-19 impacted Fall 2020/21 enrollment broadly. It is estimated that 4,130 high school students would have been enrolled as of FL20 census had it not been for obstacles associated with the pandemic.
