Comments:

State licensure in Dental Hygiene is required in all states. To obtain licensure upon graduation, a student must graduate from a Dental Hygiene Program accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA), and pass both the National Board Dental Hygiene Exam and a Clinical Board Exam. Most states now require a course in local anesthesia and nitrous oxide sedation, however not all states have this requirement. California, Washington, and Oregon have requirements above the minimum that are "expanded function" so they may require students to take additional course work prior to licensure.
