

CC Challenges: Completing STARS

- Consistent info?? (turnover & minimal records)
- Older archival systems
- Lack of resources, incl time & staffing
- Often falls to 1 or 2 staff persons
- 17 rated schools may not be convincing to administration for need/use
- Budget issues taking precedent
