Perfect 100% NREMT first-attempt cognitive pass rate — 29 points above the national average of 70.98%.

100% positive placement rate — every graduate in Cohort 44 secured employment in the EMS field or continued in higher education or joined the military.

100% 3rd-attempt cumulative pass rate — exceeding the 2024 national cumulative average of 86.66% by over 13 points.

86.67% retention rate reflects a high-standards curriculum with strong student support.
