



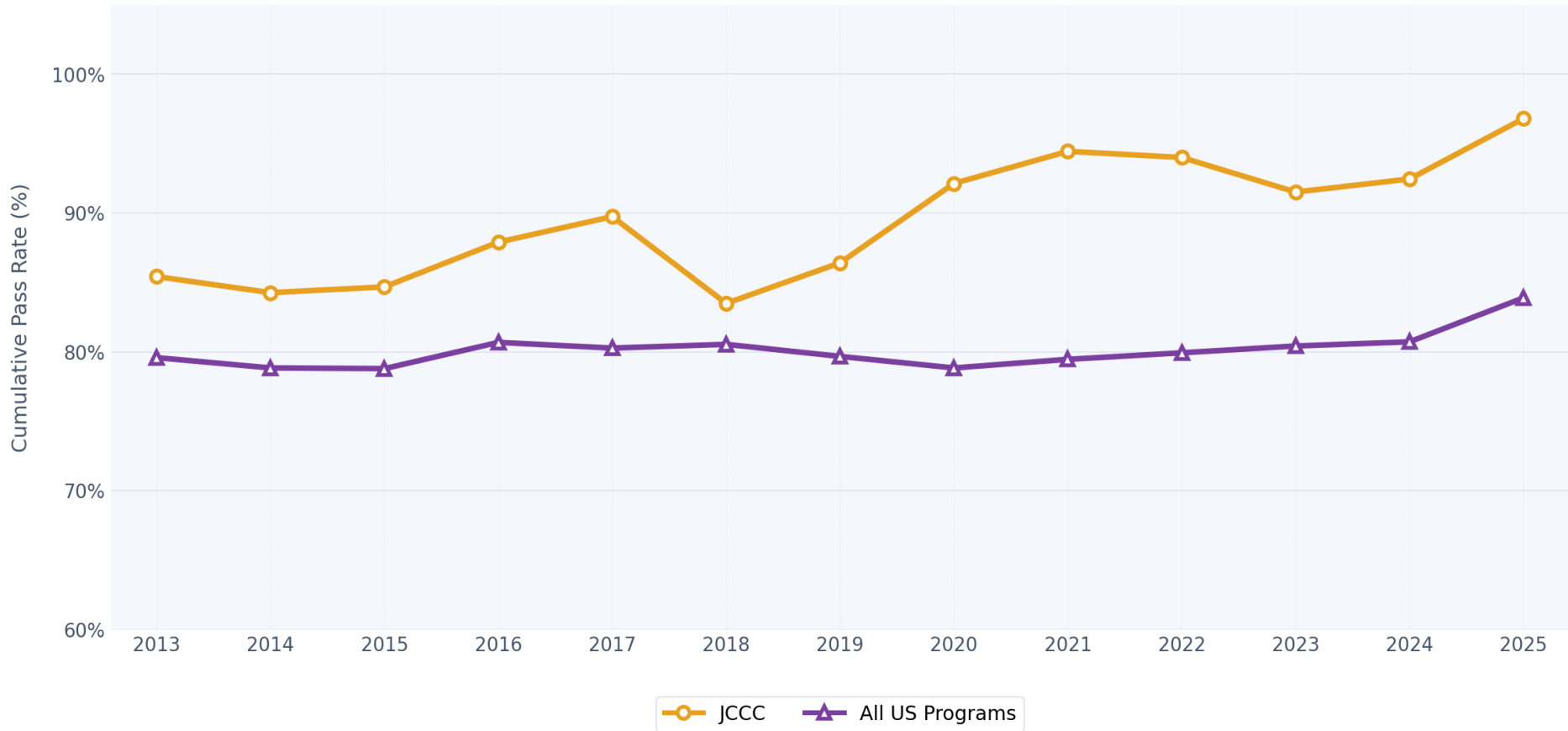

Key Takeaways

JCCC's EMT 3rd-attempt cumulative pass rate has trended strongly upward, reaching 96.8% in 2025.

JCCC consistently outperforms the national average (79–84%) across all 13 years.

The national EMT cumulative rate has been remarkably stable at 78–84% over the entire period.

JCCC's gap over the US average has grown from ~6 pts (2013) to over 13 pts (2025), showing program improvement.
