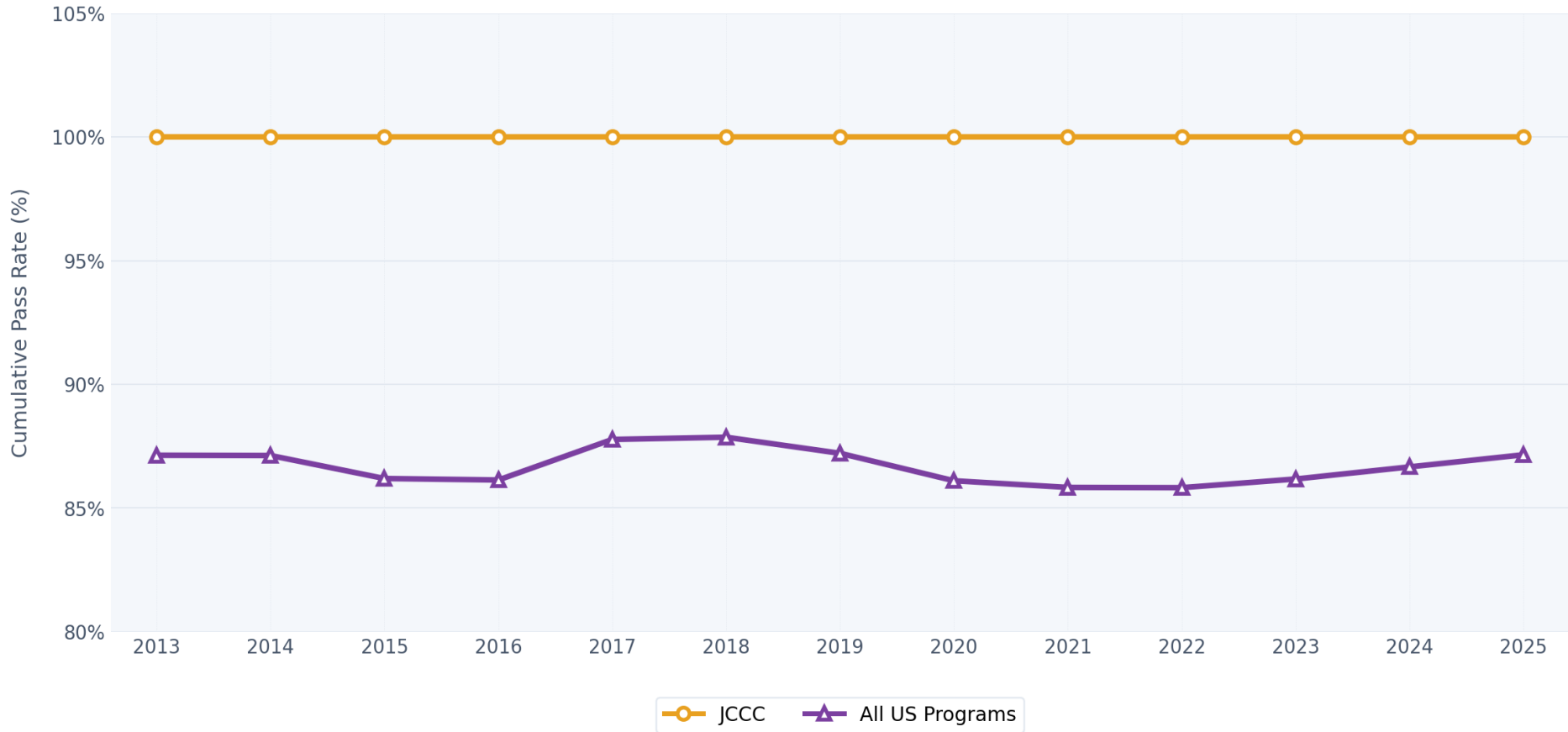

Key Takeaways

JCCC achieved a perfect 100% 2nd-attempt cumulative pass rate in all 13 years from 2013–2025.

The national data is aggregated by National 3rd attempt pass so this is the closest comparison benchmark.

JCCC's cumulative advantage over the US average ranges from +12 to +14 percentage points every year.

The consistency of JCCC's perfect record across 13 years is a strong indicator of program quality and student support.
