




**Cumulative 3rd Attempt Pass Rate Comparison** 








**Cumulative 6th Attempt Pass Rate Comparison**

**Paramedic Program Retention** 



JCCC Paramedic



Retention is computed using the total number of students that completed in the most recent reporting year (2018) and is calculated by determining the attrition (the number of students who dropped out divided by the total number of students enrolled). Once the attrition has been determined, the retention percentage is 100% minus the attrition percentage.

Positive job placement means that the graduate is employed full-time or parttime or volunteers in the profession; or in a related field; or is continuing his/her education; or serving in the military. A related field is one in which the individual is using cognitive, psychomotor and affective competencies is acquired in Paramedic education program.



1st Attempt Pass Rate Comparison





National 3<sup>rd</sup> Attempt




