

Steps to Enroll for Spring 2020

- 1. Apply for Admission** at admissions.jccc.edu. To ensure your eligibility to enroll before the semester begins, apply no later than **December 6, 2019**. When your application is processed, you will receive an email that includes your JCCC ID number and login information. Information on previous college and high school transcript submission requirements can be found on the "Transcript Requirements" page on the admissions website.
- 2. Apply for Financial Aid** online at fafsa.gov. Use 008244 as the JCCC school code when you complete the electronic FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). Log in to your MyJCCC student account to view your financial aid status. A list of financial aid requirements will be displayed. These requirements must all be met before your financial aid can be awarded. If your financial aid file is complete by **November 15, 2019**, your accepted financial aid will protect your enrollment until funds are available. Don't forget to apply for JCCC scholarships at jccc.edu/scholarships.
- 3. Attend Orientation** in the Student Center or online. Visit jccc.edu/orientation for more information, including times live orientations are available (no sign-up required). If this is your first time in college, orientation must be completed to fulfill your Personal Admission Plan requirement. New and transfer JCCC I-20 students must contact the International and Immigrant Student Services Office at 913-469-7680 for orientation requirements and important deadlines.
- 4. Complete Placement Testing** if required. Placement testing or submission of eligible ACT scores is required for admission of most degree-seeking students. Some courses at JCCC also require placement testing prior to enrollment. Visit jccc.edu/testing for exemptions to testing and study guides. Students who need disability accommodation for the placement test may contact Access Services at accessservices@jccc.edu.
- 5. Meet with a Counselor** for assistance with academic advising, transfer information, personal or career counseling, and disability accommodations. Students should call 913-469-3809 to schedule an appointment with a counselor or an Access Services counselor. For more information, go to jccc.edu/counseling.
- 6. Enroll in Classes** online by logging in to your MyJCCC account. Enrollment dates are available in the Academic Calendar on the back of this publication and drop deadlines for classes may be viewed on our website. If you intend to enroll in a course that has a prerequisite that you successfully completed at another college, JCCC must receive and evaluate your official transcript or a counselor must review your unofficial transcript and issue a waiver prior to enrollment in the course. Official transcript evaluation may take up to four weeks from date received. **Class closed? Waitlisting may be an option!**

**To receive the 60+ rate you must enroll on or after the designated 60+ enrollment date, be a Johnson County resident, and be at least 60 years of age prior to the first day of the semester.

- 7. Pay Tuition by 6 p.m. on January 14, 2020.** Tuition may be paid online or in person at the Bursar Office. Enrollment will be closed on January 14 from 6 to 9 p.m. for drop for nonpayment processing. Payment is due on the date of enrollment for students adding classes after 9 p.m. on January 14. Students are financially responsible for all charges on their account. For more information about paying tuition, go to jccc.edu/admissions/tuition.
- 8. Obtain Your Student ID Card** at the Student Engagement Desk or in Billington Library. You may obtain an ID card after your credit tuition is paid through third party authorization, financial aid, enrollment in a payment plan, or the balance is paid in full by you.
- 9. Purchase Textbooks** at the JCCC Bookstore. Save time by ordering or reserving books online at bookstore.jccc.edu beginning **November 18, 2019**. Textbooks become available in the bookstore on **December 9, 2019**. JCCC ID and a credit card are required to rent textbooks. JCCC ID card is required to use financial aid and book voucher funds. Textbook rentals are due back in the bookstore no later than **May 23, 2020**.

- 16 Spring schedule of classes becomes available on the web.

- 21-23 **Spring pre-enrollment** begins at 8 a.m. for students who have applied for graduation or are required to enroll in a developmental education course. Career program students are also eligible to enroll at this time (excludes Liberal Arts, General Sciences, General Studies and non-degree seeking students).

- 23 **Open enrollment begins on the web at 9 p.m. for spring classes.**

- 25 Enrollment for spring CNA courses (AVHO 102) begins at 8 a.m.

December

- 6 New and readmitted students are encouraged to apply by this date to ensure enrollment by the start of the spring semester.

- 21-Jan. 1 Winter break. College closed.

January 2020

- 2 Staff on 10-month contract return.

- 14 Staff on 9-month contract return.

- 14 **Payment deadline – 6 p.m.** All students enrolling prior to this deadline must pay tuition and fees by 6 p.m. or risk being dropped from classes. Enrollment will be closed from 6 to 9 p.m. for drop for nonpayment processing. Payment is due on the date of enrollment for students adding classes after 9 p.m. on Jan. 14.

- 14 Web enrollment reopens at 9 p.m.

- 14-17 Professional development days for faculty. College offices open.

- 17 Credit enrollment for students eligible for the 60+ tuition rate begins at 8 a.m.

- 18 **Saturday extended hours for enrollment:** Success Center will be open 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Testing Center will be open 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

- 20 Martin Luther King Jr. Day. College closed.

- 21 **First day of spring credit classes.**

- 21-22 **Late registration:** After these dates, students must be enrolled in a course no later than the first day the course meets.

- 28 Last day to drop a full-semester course and receive a 100-percent refund.

February

- 17 Application deadline to apply for spring graduation.

- 17 Last day to drop a full-semester course without a withdrawal “W” on the student’s permanent record. Deadline is 11 p.m. for drops completed on the web.

March

- 16-22 Spring Break. Classes not in session. College offices open Monday through Friday.

April

- 6-8 **Summer pre-enrollment** begins at 8 a.m. for students who have applied for graduation or are required to enroll in a developmental education course. Career program students are also eligible to enroll at this time (excludes Liberal Arts, General Sciences, General Studies and non-degree seeking students).

- 8 **Open enrollment begins on the web at 9 p.m. for summer classes.**

- 10 Enrollment for summer CNA courses (AVHO 102) begins at 8 a.m.

- 15 Last day to request a pass/fail grade option or to withdraw with a “W” from a full-semester course.

- 20-22 **Fall pre-enrollment** begins at 8 a.m. for students who have applied for graduation or are required to enroll in a developmental education course. Career program students are also eligible to enroll at this time (excludes Liberal Arts, General Sciences, General Studies and non-degree seeking students).

- 22 **Open enrollment begins on the web at 9 p.m. for fall classes.**

- 24 Enrollment for fall CNA courses (AVHO 102) begins at 8 a.m.

May

- 1 Deadline for faculty to submit grade changes for “I” grades assigned in the fall semester.

- 16-21 Final exams.

- 16 Saturday classes end.

- 17 Sunday classes end.

- 22 Last day for staff on 9-month contract.

- 22 Last day of spring semester.

- 22 Commencement.

- 25 Memorial Day Holiday. College offices closed.

- 26 Grades entered online by professors by 5 p.m.

- 27 Last day for staff on 10-month contract.

- 28 Grades available to students by noon on the web.
