- 1) Call to order
 - President Tiger Harris-Webster called the General Assembly to order at 12:04 pm
- 2) Adoption of Agenda
 - Senator Julia Fraley made a motion to accept the agenda, and senator Caroline Beardall seconded it.
 - Parliamentarian Ankeet Prasai motioned to table the acceptance of the minutes from April 8th to the next General Assembly. Vice President Caleb Keltner seconded the motion.
 - Secretary Fernanda Morales motioned to move the “Elections” before “Ad-hoc update” on the agenda, Parliamentarian Ankeet Prasai seconded the motion. All senators voted in favor.
 - Senators voted all in favor of accepting the agenda.
- 3) Guest welcome
 - President Tiger Harris- Webster welcomed the guest.
- 4) Committee Reports
 - Secretary Fernanda Morales asked the senators if they liked receiving the agenda on the WhatsApp. Senator Katia Rivera-Cobian wished to have the minutes and agenda uploaded to google docs.
 - Vice-Chair Julia Fraley gave the committee report for Public Relations. She said they worked on a bulletin board.
 - Vice-Chair Chris Bergin said that the Budget Committee did not during the previous week.
 - Vice-Chair Arielle Von Der Heyde said that the Service and Fundraising Committee are working on the clothing pantry.
- 5) New Business
 - Budget request – Honor Student Association had a budget request of \$1,673.70 They are wishing to hold their Place as Text course trip to St. Louis for JCCC Honors students that sign up for the event . The Budget Committee recommended to allocate 98% of their request which is a total of \$1640.23
 - i. Vice President Caleb Keltner motioned to accept the recommendation of

the Budget committee, Parliamentarian Ankeet Prasai seconded the motion. The motion passed with 11 votes in favor, and 7 abstentions (Senators who are members of HAS abstained during the voting).

- Elections- Candidates for the 2019-2020 secretary position gave their small speech and answered some questions to the senate. Senators voted for the next Student Senate secretary.
- Constitution Changes- Parliamentarian Ankeet Prasai presented changes to the constitution addressing the vice-chairs position
 - i. Advisor Anne Turney informed the senate that the desired scholarships for the vice-chairs next school year was not guaranteed.
 - ii. Parliamentarian Ankeet Prasai motioned to accept the changes to the constitution, Secretary Fernanda Morales seconded the motion. Senators voted all in favor.
- Ad-hoc Update – Senator Caroline Beardall talked about everyday hero, meal share program, employment and intership opportunities that are or could be offered at the school.
