- (1) Call to order
 - President Tiger Harris-Webster called the General Assembly meeting to order at 12:10pm.
- (2) Adoption of agenda
 - Motion to adopt the agenda by Treasurer Samuel Chaney, was seconded by Senator Dakota Morrison and the agenda was adopted. 17 votes in favor.
- (3) Guest Welcome
 - President Tiger Harris-Webster welcomed guest Lauren Jacobs from the math department. Lauren Jacobs talked about the math resource center moving to the first floor of the library in the near future. The current location of the math resource center will be vacated. Therefore the math department was thinking of turning that space into a student lounge. She also proposed that the coffee shop at CLB to move inside this student lounge. This idea would be beneficial to the school because it opens up more rooms for seating. It also will expand the computer lab in that room and more study rooms will be available.
 - Lauren Jacobs asked for feedback from the senators. Senators liked the idea. President Tiger Harris- Webster proposed making the entrance of that room wider. Vice-president Caleb Keltner suggested making the entrance similar to the entrance of the Co-Lab. Parliamentarian Ankeet Prasai played with the idea of having a room for Student Senate.
 - The guests said they would be attending the Student Feedback Event on Oct. 12th to share this idea with the students.
- (4) New Business
 - Vice-president Caleb Keltner reminded senators that they have access to early enrollment.
 - Senator Chris Bergin said early enrollment opens up Oct. 22nd
