- 1) Call to order
 - President Tiger Harris-Webster called the General Assembly to order at 12:03 pm
- 2) Adoption of Agenda
 - Senator Dakota Morrison motioned to modify the minutes, in which he wanted to clarify that KOPS are not removing the AED, they just plan to get a new one. 18votes in favor.
 - Motion to adopt the agenda by Senator Dakota Morrison, was seconded by Senator Erica Demby and the agenda was adopted. 18 votes in favor.
- 3) Guest welcome
 - President Tiger Harris- Webster welcomed the guests who were representing the Soccer Club.
- 4) New Business
 - Soccer Club had a budget request for reimbursement. The executive board of their club plus an advisor went to see a professional Sporting KC soccer game. The soccer club requested a total of \$157.50
 - i. The Budget Committee suggested allocating 100% of their request.
 - ii. Senator Katia Rivera-Cobian moved to accept the recommended amount of 100% suggested by the Budget committee. Senator Julia Fraley seconded. 18 votes in favor.
 - President Tiger Harris-Webster notified the senators of the Board of Trustees meeting on Tuesday, Oct 16th at 5pm. President Tiger Harris-Webster will give updates of the accomplishments and future projects of Student Senate.
- 5) Old Business
 - Vice president Caleb Keltner handed out a sign-up sheet for Trick or Treat for Kids. Senators need to volunteer for at least 1 hour and 15 minutes.
 - Parliamentarian Ankeet Prasai made a few changes to the Public Relations Bylaws.
 - i. Senator Julia Fraley motioned to accept the changes to the Public Relations Bylaws. Senator Kimberlyn Crane seconded. 18 votes in favor.
- 6) Committee Reports
 - Vice chair Dakota Morrison gave reports on the Rules and Conduct committee. They

revised the Public Relations committee and made a few changes to it. They also talked about doing some team building exercises before General Assemblies in order encourage more participation in our meetings.

- Vice chair Julia Fraley gave reports on the Public Relations committee. They met last week at the Student Feedback event.
- Vice chair Kimberlyn Crane gave the report on the Service and Fundraising committee. They worked on the Trick or Treat for Kids poster. They also decided on an activity for that event.
- Vice chair Chris Bergin gave reports on the Budget committee. They had a budget request from the Soccer club.

7) Executive Announcements

- Treasurer Samuel Chaney encouraged senators to participate in Trick or Treat for Kids.
- Vice president Caleb Keltner announced the dates for Trick or Treat as well as Interclub meeting.
- President Tiger Harris-Webster announced the times for the Board of Trustees meeting and also said to dress business casual if senators decide to attend the meeting.

8) Advisor Announcements

- Advisor Anne Turney announce Senior day which is on Wednesday, Oct 17th from 10:30 am – 11 am. They are looking for student feedback. Senator Kimberlyn Crane will be there and others are welcomed to attend as well.
- Also, JCCC is shooting a commercial, in which they are looking for extra students. President Tiger Harris-Webster, Vice president Caleb Keltner, and Senator Erica Demby will be in the commercial. More students are needed, those interested contact Advisor Anne Turney.

9) Open Forum

- Senator Chris Bergin said the entrance doors in the Regnier Center and CoLab are a bit awkward to open. He raised the questions whether Student Senate could do something about it.
- Senator Philip Raynolds suggested creating Ad-Hoc committee to address facility issues on campus.
- Senator Dakota Morrison encouraged more participation from senators at the General Assembly.
- Senator Xiao Ren said the new changes to the Public Relations Bylaws does not really make a specific sentence complete.
- Senator Erica Demby gave an announcement. Sharice Davis is visiting JCCC on Wednesday, Oct. 17th from 2 pm- 3 pm at the CoLab. This event is hosted by the Black Student Union.
 - i. Also, Multicultural Day was happening on Monday Oct. 15th from 11pm to 2 pm.
- Treasurer Sam Chaney announced that Tuesday, Oct 16th is the last day to register to vote. One way to register to vote can be online, the only thing needed is a driver's license.
- Senator Philip Raynolds announced that the last day to register for graduation this semester is on this same Monday, Oct 15th.
- Advisor Anne Turney said there would be a voter registration table on Tuesday, Oct. 17th.
- Vice president Caleb Keltner reminded the senators that Student Senate is not supposed to endorse a candidate or political party. Senators can support whom ever

they want but cannot use the name of Student Senate to support a side.

- Senator Philip Raynolds had a meeting with Advisor Anne Turney. They talked about forming an Ad-Hoc committee for Student Senate benefits. They are considering increasing the amount of free printing for senators, getting possible discounts in the book store as well as the C-store, and getting a free parking spot for Student Senate.
- President Tiger Harris-Webster informed students that General Assembly is the time to bring already thought out projects, and that research should be done outside of General Assembly.

- Senator Julia Fraley motioned to adjourn, Senator Katia Rivera-Cobian seconded the motion, and the meeting was adjourned. All were in favor.
