General Assembly 2018-19

- 1) Call to order
 - President Tiger Harris-Webster called the General Assembly to order at 12:03 pm
- 2) Adoption of Agenda
 - Treasurer Sam Chaney motioned to move the Budget request presentation from SKAI until they arrived to General Assembly.
 - Motion to adopt the agenda by Senator Dakota Morrison, was seconded by Senator Katia Rivera- Cobian and the agenda was adopted. 16 votes in favor.
- 3) Guest welcome
 - President Tiger Harris- Webster welcomed the guests who were representing the campus ledger.
- 4) New Business
 - Exec board members encouraged senators to recruit future members of Student Senate.
 - i. Senator Chris Bergin talked about the suggestion box for Student Senate. President Tiger Harris- Webster suggested that the Public Relations committee should take a look at the wording for that suggestion box.
- 5) Old Business
 - Vice President Caleb Keltner reminded senators that Trick or Treat for Kids is the upcoming Friday, Oct. 26th. He also reminded that senators are able to pre-enroll on this day Oct. 22nd
