- 1) Call to order
 - President Tiger Harris-Webster called the General Assembly to order at 12:02 pm
- 2) Adoption of Agenda
 - Senator Julia Fraley made a motion to accept the minutes and agenda, and senator Caroline Beardall seconded it. The motion passed with all votes in favor.

 - Rob Wirick, Director of the JCCC Foundation –
