- 1) Call to order
 - President Tiger Harris-Webster called the General Assembly to order at 12:03 pm
- 2) Adoption of Agenda
 - Senator Julia Fraley made a motion to accept the minutes and agenda, and senator Caroline Beardall seconded it. The motion passed with 18 votes in favor, and 1 abstention.
- 3) Guest welcome
- 4) Executive Board Announcements
 - Vice President Caleb Keltner said there will be an InterClub meeting on Friday, March 29th at noon .
 - Treasurer Sam Chaney said there was a Budget Committee meeting on Wednesday at noon.
- 5) New Business
 - Budget request – Veterans Club had a budget request of \$691.25. They are wishing to have a special graduation cording ceremony for the JCCC veterans. . The Budget Committee recommended to allocate 100% of their request which is a total of \$691.25
 - i. Senator Julia Fraley motioned to accept the recommendation of the Budget committee, Senator Caroline Beardall seconded the motion. The motion passed with 19 votes in favor. (Senators who are members of the veterans club did not participate in the voting)
 - Potential Partnership – The Center of Student Involvement, along with MOCSA would like to partner up with Student Senate. The main goal of MOCSA is to combat sexual assault. The event would be held on Wednesday , April 3rd.
 - i. Advisor Anne Turney said that the Center of Student Involvement was planning to handout donuts in the morning of the event (April 3rd) . Later on that afternoon make paper cranes.
 - ii. The event costs a total of \$6,000.
 - iii. Student Senate would ideally contribute \$2,000
 - iv. Treasurer Sam Chaney motioned to pledge \$200 with another \$500 on

condition of another pledge from an outside organization, Senator Julia Fraley seconded it. The motion passed with all votes in favor.

- Impeachment - Parliamentarian Ankeet Prasai started the impeachment process for Katina Dyson-Dixon. She had more than the allowed number of absences, and she did not get in touch with the Student Senate exec board.
 - i. Parliamentarian Ankeet Prasai motioned to impeach Katina Dyson – Dixon, Vice President Caleb Keltner seconded the motion. Senators voted 19 in favor, 1 against, and 1 abstention.
- New Positions/ Vice Chair – Parliamentarian Ankeet Prasai introduced the idea of giving more responsibilities and benefits to committee vice-chairs. In the next following weeks, he will be drafting new changes to the constitution about
