(1) Call to order

- President Tiger Harris-Webster called the General Assembly meeting to order at 12:00 pm.

(2) Adoption of agenda

- Motion to adopt the agenda by President Tiger Harris- Webster, was seconded by Senator Kimberlyn Crane and the agenda was adopted. 17 votes in favor.

(3) Guest Welcome

- President Tiger Harris-Webster welcomed the guests

(4) New Business

- Treasurer Samuel Chaney talked about the steps of forming an Ad Hoc committee to address parking issue discussed on September 10, 2018.
- Treasure Samuel Chaney went over the funding request process. He explained that the form can be found on Get Involved and that all clubs and orgs have access to it. The Budget committee oversees evaluating the Budget Requests and General Assembly will vote.
- Parliamentarian Ankeet Prasai talked about the vice chair positions available within each standing committee. He went over how that process works in the Constitution page 10.
- Parliamentarian Ankeet Prasai went over changes to the constitution. Senators no longer need to refer to D2L since all the forms can now be found on Get Involved. Senators also need to check WhatsApp as the main source of communication every 3 days.

- Secretary Fernanda Morales went over the attendance policy. Senators have up to 4 unexcused absences. They need to notify Secretary Fernanda Morales 24 hours previous being absent to be considered an excused absence. Attendance will be counted against if a senator misses General Assembly, standing committee, campus wide committee or other events requiring attendance Student senate.

- Advisor Anne Turney gave announcements on upcoming events. Constitution day was on Monday September 17, 2018 from 11am- 1pm.
- President Tiger Harris-Webster went over the upcoming events listed in the Agenda of Sept. 17, 2018.

(6) Open Forum

- Senator Philip Raynolds talked about the Sustainability Campus Wide Committee needing one more Student Senate representative at their meetings. Senator Xiao Ran.
 - i. President Tiger Harris- Webster explained to senators of the different committees of Student Senate. He encouraged senators to sign up for a Campus Wide Committee.
- Advisor Anne Turney showed senators how to access the Get Involved website.
- Senator Philip Raynolds asked for Executive board members to clarify committee times.
 - i. Not everyone had signed up for a standing committee and President Harris- Webster took a time to assign every senator a standing committee.
- Senator Xiao Ren raised the issue that students are driving above the speed limit within the JCCC area.
 - i. Senator Dakota Morrison suggested adding more speed limit signs around the school.
 - ii. Vice-President Caleb Keltner encouraged senators to form an Ad-Hoc committee in order to address this issue. To form an Ad-Hoc committee at least two senators must be involved.
 - iii. Senator Kimberlyn Crane shared her experiences driving to JCCC. She asked if more traffic lights can be added at intersections near JCCC.
