PROCLAMATION
BY THE
GOVERNOR

TO THE PEOPLE OF KANSAS, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Johnson County Community College (JCCC) is a public institution of higher education located in Overland Park, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, JCCC's Women's Basketball Team is proudly celebrating its 50 year anniversary at the college; and

WHEREAS, JCCC's Women's Basketball Team finished the 2024-2025 season undefeated in their league with a 34-1 overall record under Head Coach Ben Conrad; and

WHEREAS, JCCC's Women's Basketball Team's perseverance, skill and teamwork earned them a spot in the NJCAA Division II national women's basketball championship on March 22, 2025 at the Leggett & Platt Athletic Center in Joplin, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, in this evenly matched game that featured 12 ties and 16 lead changes, JCCC defeated the Pima Community College Aztecs 75-67 to bring the national championship back to the State of Kansas; and

WHEREAS, this win gave Coach Conrad his second NJCAA Division II title and the JCCC Women's Basketball its third national championship in program history.
