



- These requirements are effective for all students whose first enrollment in an accredited college or university occurs in the fall of 2009 or later.
- General Education core requirements are common to all degrees regardless of major. However, there are some requirements unique to specific majors. Students majoring in business, elementary education, secondary education, or nursing should refer to those respective transfer guides. Art majors and Information Resource majors should refer to the General Education Requirements in the ESU catalog for specific course selection.
- At least 60 semester hours must be earned from a four-year college or university, 30 of those hours at Emporia State University. At least 45 semester hours must be earned in junior and senior level courses.
- **It is the STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY to check for updates to all transfer information. This transfer guide is provided as a service and is updated as needed. Degree requirements at the four-year colleges are subject to change by those institutions. To ensure you have the most accurate up to date information about the program, it is imperative you meet with an advisor at the transfer institution.**
