



## Admission Requirements

- These requirements are effective for all students whose first enrollment in an accredited college or university occurs in the fall of 2012 or later.
- Completion of the Newman Division of Nursing Application procedure. Applications for admission to the nursing major are due May 1 for August entry. Applicants should have completed the **following 30 credit hours of admission prerequisite courses or equivalent courses by the spring semester of the application year.** Applicants who need to complete no more than 6 nursing prerequisite hours in summer should submit with the application a written request for special consideration: **English (121 & 122), Math (one of 171, 165, 173, 241, 231, 232), Biology (121), Chemistry (122), Psychology (130), Developmental Psychology (218), Speech (121), and Sociology (122 or 125).**
- The required standardized pre-admission test as designated by the Newman Division of Nursing must be completed as part of the application process. Test information, including testing dates, is available from the nursing office. Students are responsible for reserving a test date and time and for paying the costs associated with the pre-admission test by May 1.
