TRANSFER ADMISSION PROCEDURES/QUALIFICATIONS

Application:

- File the SUNY Application Online.
- Submit <u>Supplemental Materials</u>: Admissions Essay, School Transcripts, Portfolio, English Proficiency, and SAT and ACT Scores.
- Fall Semester Admission January 1: Application Deadline; February 1: Supplemental Materials Deadline; April May: All final transcripts and test scores must be submitted before students register for the fall semester.
- Spring Semester Admission October 1: Application Deadline; November 1: Supplemental Materials
 Deadline; December January: All final transcripts and test scores must be submitted before students
 register for the spring semester.

Transcripts:

- Arrange to have all official secondary and post-secondary transcripts sent directly from your schools to
 FIT. Electronic delivery of transcripts will be the quickest way to receive and process your documents.
 The Admissions office will accept electronic transcripts from the following approved vendors:
