

Johnson County Community College Transfer Program to the University of Kansas School of Education and Human Sciences Health, Sport, and Exercise Sciences Physical Education Plus (B.S.E.) 2024-2025 Catalog

The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.A. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. degree requires completion of 60 credit hours; please see JCCC A.A. degree requirements. The maximum number of hours from a community college that will be applied toward a bachelor's degree at KU is 75 hours. Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.

- The Physical Education Plus program prepares individuals to meet requirements for a physical education teaching endorsement in the state of Kansas and prepare them to pursue endorsement in an additional secondary field such as Health, Middle-level Math, Middle-level Science, English, Speech/Theatre, or psychology; or complete a minor in Sport Management or Business.
- Students can be admitted into PE Plus as transfer students if they are admitted to KU, declare PE Plus as their major, and meet the following criteria:
 - A KU + Transfer Cumulative GPA of at least 2.75
- A student must earn a grade of "C-" or higher in KU CORE 34 written and oral communication courses and quantitative literacy courses. Minimum grades are also required in some specific designated PE Plus courses.
- A maximum of 75 hours may be transferred to KU from community colleges. Students should be aware that 45 junior/senior credit hours are required for completion of the bachelor's degree; 30 of those hours must be at KU; and community college courses do not transfer as junior/senior hours.
- Only 6 hours of Credit/No Credit is allowed for general education courses. A student cannot take a class Credit/No Credit for any major requirement.
- Minimum total hours for graduation is 120.
- Effective Fall 2024: Students transferring to KU, with an AA, AFA or AS degree from JCCC will be considered to have satisfied KU's Core 34 general education curriculum.
- Effective Fall 2024: Students who transfer to KU, without completing AA, AFA or AS degree will have courses evaluated on a course-by-course basis toward meeting KU requirements.
