The Kanas Board of Regents (KBOR) has approved the Systemwide General Education Framework below for the 2024-25 academic year. It is comprised of 34-35 credit hours organized in six discipline-based "buckets" and an institutionally designed bucket. A student who satisfies all seven buckets will complete the systemwide GE program.

Please note this framework applies to the completion of the Associate of Arts (AA), Associate of Fine Arts (AFA) and Associate of Science (AS) degrees only. Students that have not earned an AA, AFA, or AS, will have coursework reviewed on a course by course basis.

The Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree and the Associate of General Studies (AGS) degree do <u>not</u> apply to the KBOR Systemwide General Education Framework. Please see your JCCC Counselor if you are pursing the AAS or AGS degree.
