



The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.A. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. degree requires completion of 63 credit hours. The maximum number of hours from a community college that will be applied toward a bachelor's degree at most four-year schools is 64. **Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.**

- Minimum of 120 hours required for this degree.
- Minimum of 30 hours of upper level credit (3000/4000) required. Courses taken at JCCC may be articulated as equivalent to upper level classes but WILL NOT count towards the 30 hours of upper level credit required.
- Minimum of 12 hours of upper level credit (3000/4000) required in the major.
- Courses taken to fulfill General Education requirements may not be taken on the pass/fail basis.
- Kansas residents admitted regularly to UCM pay the equivalent of in-state tuition. For more information visit ucmo.edu/instate.
