The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.A. allows students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. degree requires completion of 64 credit hours, the maximum number of hours from a community college that will be applied toward a bachelor's degree at most four-year schools.  
**Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses**

PLAN (Partnership for Learning and Networking) is an on-line Bachelor's Degree Completion Program offered cooperatively by Washburn University and Johnson County Community College. This high-quality, flexible program allows a student with an associates degree to complete a bachelor's degree without relocating. Students may start the program any semester.

### **Admission Requirements**

- Apply for admission, including \$20 application fee (non-refundable). Complete the application on-line at [www.washburn.edu/admissions](http://www.washburn.edu/admissions).

- Academic good standing; minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0

### **Requirements for Bachelor's Degree**

- Minimum of 124 semester hours of credit
- Minimum of 60 semester hours from Washburn or a four-year college or university; at least 30 hours must be completed through Washburn
- Minimum of 45 semester hours of credit from courses at the upper division level
- Minimum of 84 graded hours
- Grade of "C" or better in courses counting towards the university requirements, major, and minor
- Students must have an associates degree

### **Benefits of Associate of Arts Degree**

- Students who complete the A.A. automatically complete the EN 101 (ENGL 121) and MA 116 (MATH 171) requirements
- Students who complete the A.A. automatically complete 12 hours of credit that will count towards Washburn's Arts and Humanities requirement
- Students who complete the A.A. automatically complete 6 hours of credit that will count towards Washburn's Social Science requirement
- Students who complete the A.A. automatically complete 7 hours of credit that will count towards Washburn's Natural Science, Mathematics and Statistics requirement
