 - Apply for admission, including \$20 application fee (non-refundable). Complete the application online at www.washburn.edu/admissions

 - Academic good standing; minimum cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Students must also apply and be admitted into the School of Nursing. Please contact the School of Nursing for its admission requirements.
- Requirements for Bachelor's Degree:
 - Minimum of 120 semester hours of credit.
 - Minimum of 60 semester hours from Washburn or a four-year college or university; at least 30 hours must be completed through Washburn.
 - Minimum of 45 semester hours of credit from courses at the upper division level.
 - Minimum of 84 graded hours.
 - Grade of C or better in courses counting toward the university requirements and toward the major.
