The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.A. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. degree requires completion of 60 credit hours. Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.

The focus of the Technology Administration program is on the application of technology in administration, economics, leadership, safety, management, production and service. You will build on your previous courses and gain additional knowledge to help advance your career in your chosen field.

You can complete the majority of the courses online or create a program with a combination of face-to-face and online courses. Flexibility is the key to the Washburn University Technology Administration program, allowing you to work full or part-time, attend classes in Topeka or from across the nation, and complete your degree on your schedule.

Admission Requirements

- Apply for admission, including \$20 application fee (non-refundable). Complete the application online at www.washburn.edu/admissions.

- Academic good standing; minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0

Requirements for Bachelor's Degree

- Minimum of 120 semester hours of credit
- Minimum of 60 semester hours from Washburn or a four-year college or university; at least 30 hours must be completed through Washburn
- Minimum of 45 semester hours of credit from courses at the upper division level
- Minimum of 84 graded hours
- Grade of "C" or better in courses counting towards the university requirements, major, and minor
