The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The 30 hours of electives within the A.A. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. degree requires completion of 60 credit hours. The maximum number of hours from a community college that will be applied toward a bachelor's degree at most four-year schools is between 60 and 63 credit hours or 50% of the degree. Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.

- Students are required to complete 60 or more hours from an accredited college or complete an associate degree with at least a 2.0 in all transferable coursework.
- Students with less than a 2.0 GPA may be considered for admission on a provisional basis. The degree-completion programs in Education and Nursing (RN-BSN) have additional, specific requirements.
- Degrees are 120 hours minimum and 30 of the final 36 hours must be completed at CMU.
- CMU will transfer up to 88 hours towards a bachelor's degree.
- Students must have 36 hours of upper division (300 or higher) coursework from a four-year school.
- Students must have a minimum of 15 hours of upper division coursework in their major.
- Costs - Undergraduate is \$220/credit hour, Undergraduate online is \$260/credit hour

It is the STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY to check for updates to all transfer information. This transfer guide is provided as a service and is updated as needed. Degree requirements at the four-year colleges are subject to change by those institutions. To ensure you have the most accurate up to date information about the program, it is imperative you meet with an advisor at the transfer institution.
