The Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree in Nursing at JCCC allows for a seamless progression for licensed registered nurses to obtain their Bachelor of Sciences in Nursing (B.S.N.) degree at Central Methodist University. **Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.**

- Students are required to complete 60 or more hours from an accredited college or complete an associates degree with at least a 2.0 in all transferable coursework.
- Students with less than a 2.0 GPA may be considered for admission on a provisional basis. The degree completion programs in Education and Nursing (RN-BSN) have additional, specific requirements.
- Degrees are 120 hours minimum and 30 of the final 36 hours must be completed at CMU.
- CMU will transfer up to 88 hours towards a bachelor's degree
- Students must have 36 hours of upper division (300 or higher) coursework from a four year school.
- Students must have a minimum of 15 hours of upper division coursework in their major.
- Costs :
Undergraduate: \$220/credit hour (all locations except St. Louis).
Undergraduate online: \$260/credit hour.
