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The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) or the Associate of Fine Arts degree (A.F.A.) at JCCC are general transfer degrees and partner well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. or the A.F.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. or A.F.A. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.A. or the A.F.A. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. or the A.F.A. degree requires completion of 60 credit hours; please see [JCCC A.A. degree requirements](#) or [JCCC A.F.A. degree requirements](#). A total of 75 credit hours may be transferred to KU from community colleges. Students should be aware that 45 junior/senior hours are required for completion of the four-year degree; 30 of those hours must be taken at KU. **Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.**

- A major in the history of art is available to candidates for the B.F.A. degree. This major combines a 30-hour concentration in art history with 17 hours of studio training (beyond the 13 hours of foundation courses). A total of 120 hours is required for the degree, including 45 junior/senior hours (courses numbered 300 or higher). 30 of these 45 junior/senior hours must be taken in residence at the University of Kansas.
- In addition to completing the online application for KU Admission, [a portfolio and responses to three short essay questions](#) are required for admission to the Department of Visual Art. Information regarding these additional application materials can be found at <https://art.ku.edu/undergraduate-admissions>.
- All entering students in Visual Arts are required to participate in a foundation curriculum offered through the Foundations program before enrolling in advanced art or design studio courses. Students complete Drawing I, Drawing II, Art Concepts & Practice, Art Principles & Practice, and Visual Art Seminar (13 hours) before enrolling in advanced art or design studio courses.
- Effective Fall 2024: Students transferring to KU, with an AA, AFA or AS degree from JCCC will be considered to have satisfied KU's Core 34 general education curriculum.
- Effective Fall 2024: Students who transfer to KU, without completing AA, AFA or AS degree will have courses evaluated on a course-by-course basis toward meeting KU requirements.
