(BBA) 2022-2023 Catalog

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The KU School of Business offers a Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA), a degree completion option consisting of upper-level coursework. Required lower-level and general education coursework should be completed prior to entering the BBA program. The KU BBA program is offered in a traditional classroom-based format at the KU Edwards Campus with late afternoon and evening classes. Following are the requirements for the BBA at Edwards, which is a different degree than the BSB in Lawrence.

Admission Requirements

Minimum requirements for competitive admission to the KU School of Business BBA program at the KU Edwards Campus:

1. Completion of a minimum 60 college credit hours, which must include the following foundation (BBA prerequisite) coursework:
 - ACCT 200 Financial Accounting (ACCT 121 and ACCT 122 at JCCC)
 - ACCT 201 Managerial Accounting (ACCT 222 at JCCC)
 - IST 202 Intro to Information Systems *or* IST 205 Survey of Information Systems (CIS 201 at JCCC)
 - ECON 144 Macroeconomics (ECON 230 at JCCC)
 - ECON 142 Microeconomics (ECON 231 at JCCC)
 - MATH 365 Statistics (MATH 181 at JCCC or statistics course with a college algebra prerequisite)
 - PSYC 104 General Psychology (PSYC 130 at JCCC)
2. Minimum 2.2 GPA in all of the following versions of the GPA:
 - Overall college GPA – all college credits earned
 - Overall professional GPA – all business and economics credits earned
 - KU overall GPA – all credits earned at KU, if applicable
 - KU professional GPA – all business and economics credits earned at KU, if applicable
 - The GPAs above include any courses that are transferable to KU, and all grades in those courses are included in the transferable GPA. However, only grades of C- or higher will satisfy degree requirements.

Applying for Admission

See University Admission requirements. Apply and be admitted to the University of Kansas. Apply online at www.Admissions.KU.edu/transfers.

- Submit an official transcript from each college attended.
- Students who have completed all requirements for admission to the BBA program with appropriate GPAs will be admitted to the School of Business as a BBA student. See information below about being admitted to KU as a pre-BBA student.

Attending KU Edwards Campus as a Pre-BBA Student

Only applicants meeting the requirements above at the time of application will be considered for admission to the BBA program. In the instance that one or more of the pre-admission foundation courses has not been completed before transferring to KU, the student may apply to the University and be a pre-BBA student in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences until meeting the minimum requirements to apply. Some students even enroll at both JCCC and KU concurrently as they transition to KU Edwards. Students intending to apply to KU as pre-BBA student should meet with the academic success coach at the KU Edwards Campus before applying.

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Other Academic Considerations

- Pre-admission courses should be taken for a letter grade and not for pass/fail or credit/no credit.
- The BBA program allows for elective course options (number varies by student) that can be counted within the maximum community college credit hours AND the total credit hours required for graduation.
- Developmental and most technical courses do not transfer to the University of Kansas. To determine if a course transfers to KU, visit credittransfer.ku.edu.
- Students completing an associate's degree at JCCC must have 60 hours. Students should work with a JCCC counselor to include BBA course requirements into the associate degree. It is possible that additional community college credit hours can be applied toward a bachelor's degree at KU Edwards. Contact your KU Edwards academic success coach for more information on the limits of credit hours to be transferred as it varies by program.
- Students must earn 120 hours for graduation, of which 45 must be upper division. Thirty of the hours must be at KU. Community college courses do not transfer as junior/senior hours. Students must also satisfy the KU Core (see requirements below). Students who complete an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree at JCCC fulfill KU Core Goals 1-3.
- A minimum 30 credit hours of KU business coursework must be completed at KU after admission to the BBA program (courses in residence) prior to graduation.

It is the STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY to check for updates to all transfer information. This transfer guide is provided as a service and is updated as needed. Degree requirements at the four-year colleges are subject to change by those institutions. To ensure you have the most accurate up to date information about the program, it is imperative you meet with an advisor at the transfer institution.
