



The Associate of Science degree (A.S.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.S. may select courses that satisfy both the A.S. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.S. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.S. degree requires completion of 60 credit hours; please see [JCCC A.S. degree requirements](#). Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.

Please Note: This guide is designed for students pursuing a bachelor's degree.

The minimum requirements for graduation at Pitt State include: 120 credit hours; 60 credit hours must be from a four-year school. In addition, a minimum of 45 credit hours must be upper-division and a minimum of 30 hours must be in residence at Pitt State.

Admission Requirements: To be considered a Transfer Student, a student must successfully complete 24 college credit hours **after** high school graduation. Students not meeting this requirement will be considered incoming freshmen.

- [Apply for admission](#) and [scholarships](#) online. Priority date for scholarships is **February 1** (or **December 15** for transfer students starting in the spring semester). Submit official school transcripts and ACT test scores.
- Have your college or university transcripts sent to PSU (if any).
- Complete the [Free Application for Federal Student Aid](#) (FAFSA) beginning in **December**.
- Complete the [University Housing contract](#). Housing contracts are available in **December**.
- [Register for PITT CARES](#) (orientation and enrollment for new students). Transfer students will receive registration information in **January** for the fall semester and August for the spring semester.
- Submit your Proof of Immunization Compliance form. To view the immunization policy and to access the form, visit pittstate.edu/health.
- Transfer student with fewer than 60 credit hours must submit a final high school transcript if they will be receiving financial assistance.

General Education Requirements:

- Effective Fall 2024: Students transferring to Pitt State, with an AA, AFA or AS degree from JCCC will be considered to have satisfied Pitt State's general education curriculum.
- Effective Fall 2024: Students who transfer to Pitt State, without completing AA, AFA or AS degree will have courses evaluated on a course-by-course basis toward meeting Pitt State's requirements.
