The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.A. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. degree requires completion of 60 credit hours; please see JCCC A.A. degree requirements. Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.

BBA candidates must complete an additional 24 hours of upper-division coursework offered by the School of Business. This may be done in either of the following ways:

- A student may select courses from a variety of subject areas within the School of Business and receive a BBA with a major area of concentration in general business.
- Alternatively, a student may select courses in a way that allows them to complete one or two of the following concentrations.

Each major consists of 24 graded upper-division hours in the School of Business divided between required and elective courses.

- <u>Accounting, Concentration</u>
- Business Data Analytics, Concentration
- Economics, Concentration
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation, Concentration
- Finance, Concentration
- General Business, Concentration
- International Business, Concentration
- <u>Management, Concentration</u>
- Marketing, Concentration

Admission Requirements

- Apply for admission, including \$20 application fee (non-refundable). Complete the application online at <u>washburn.edu/admissions</u>.

Requirements for Admissions to the School of Business

- 60 hours of College Credit
- The following Lower Core Business courses with a "C" or better: AC 224 Financial Accounting, AC 225 Managerial Accounting, BU 248 Foundations of Data Analysis, BU 250 Management Information Systems, EC 200 Principles of Microeconomics, EC 201 Principles of Macroeconomics, and EC 211 Statistics for Business and Economics.

Requirements for Bachelor's Degree

- Minimum of 120 semester hours of credit
- Minimum 2.0 G.P.A.
- Minimum of 60 semester hours from Washburn or a four-year college or university; at least 30 hours must be completed through Washburn
- Minimum of 45 semester hours of credit from courses at the upper division level
- Must complete 34-35 hours of General Education, see info page 2
- Minimum of 84 graded hours
- Grade of "C" or better in courses counting towards the university core, major, correlate, and minor req.
- At least 50 percent of the major hours used to meet requirements for the BBA degree must be earned at Washburn
- 51 hours of General Education Credit

General Education

Students must complete the <u>Washburn General Education Core Requirements</u>. Effective Fall 2024: Students transferring to Washburn, with an AA, AFA or AS degree from JCCC will be considered to have satisfied Washburn's general education curriculum.

Effective Fall 2024: Students who transfer to Washburn, without completing AA, AFA or AS degree will have courses evaluated on a course-by-course basis toward meeting Washburn requirements.
