Following are the additional questions/comments submitted via note cards after the forum:

- Q. Please address how our facilities master plan with open and collaborative spaces would be safe?
- A. The full extent of facilities changes resulting from the Facilities Master Plan is still largely unknown, however please be assured that safety considerations are always top of mind when decisions are made.
- Q. I have to walk daily from RC to the bookstore. If I do not feel safe, may I ask for an escort between 8am and 1030am?
- A. Yes, JCCC campus police are available upon request to provide a security escort to campus locations or vehicles. Please contact the JCCC Police department at 913-469-2500 (913-339-6699 TDD/TTY).
- Q. I do want to see posts of the survey results. I am very concerned. I have never owned or used a gun so this feels like old west days.

- Q. With the additional insurance requirements for the college will our employee benefits go down?
- A. The full effect of this legislation on JCCC's insurance premiums, and other budgetary considerations, is not yet known.
