- A minimum of 60 semester hours must be completed at a four-year institution. The final thirty (30) hours must be completed at Avila University.
- A minimum GPA of 2.0 (C) is required for graduation in all work attempted, including transfer credits. At least 12 upper-division hours in the major must be completed at Avila.
- All upper-division courses in the major must have a minimum grade of C. All courses specifically required for the major must be completed with a grade of C or better.
- All students must complete the Avila University Core Curriculum as part of their degree programs. The Core consists of a minimum of 39 credit hours that meet the requirements below.
- Transfer students coming to Avila with an Associate of Arts (AA), a Bachelor's degree, or higher degree from
 an institution accredited by accreditors recognized by both the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA)
 and the US Department of Education (USDE), or regional accrediting bodies, will be considered to have completed
 all Skills and Liberal Arts level requirements in the core curriculum. They are still required to complete the following
 Core Component Designations:
 - IS-Interdisciplinary Studies (3 credit hours)
 GS-Global Studies or CE-Community Engagement (3 credit hours)
