- Rockhurst University uses a holistic review process when considering applications for admission.
- At least 50 percent of the upper-division business hours required for the business degree must be earned at Rockhurst.
- The BSBA is offered with concentrations in Traditional Accounting Accounting/MBA,
 Corporate Accounting and Finance, Financial Markets and Economic Analysis, International Business,
 Management, Marketing, Marketing Analytics, and Social Impact.
- JCCC's Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degrees meet most of Rockhurst's general education
 requirements. Students will need to take 3-4 additional courses to fulfill Rockhurst Core Requirements.
